Amnesty

Any person who, acting in good faith, discloses any incident or knowledge of sexual misconduct involving alcohol use, drug use, or consensual sexual activity at or near the time of the report to one of the institution's designated off cials will not be subject to disciplinary action for violations of its conduct and community lifestyle policies occurring in connection with the report, provided that behavior did not and does not place the health or safety of another at risk.

Retaliation against any participant in the reporting and investigation process is prohibited.
