All students	Upon receipt	<p>Review your financial aid offer:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Decline or reduce any unwanted financial aid using the instructions on the back of your financial aid offer. Direct loans for continuing students will be processed if not declined. Review your housing and enrollment status on your financial aid offer. If these are incorrect, indicate the correct status using the instructions on the back of your financial aid offer.
